I called this the Colors of the Mind Social Experiment because I am wearing shirts of the colors Red, Orange, Yellow, Green, Blue, Purple, Pink, White, Black and Brown 3 times in the course of three weeks. I have a Hypothesis for each shirt

White - People wont notice me but they will still respect me
Black - People will look up to me, avoid me or not even notice me

Brown - Gentle or Warm gestures toward me but people may look down upon me.
